

# My Monster Counting Book

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### Notes for the Teacher:

- To assemble the book: cut the title page in half with five additional blank pages.
- Materials: you will need to use dice to complete this activity as well. I use large foam dice so that it is easier for my students to count the dots on the dice. Students will also need pencils or crayons and monster stamps (I purchased mine from Target in their Dollar Spot).
- Procedure: students roll the dice and count how many dots, then they will stamp that many monsters on their blank page and write the number! This activity not only reinforces one to one correspondence and counting, but it's also great for probability!
